NEW LEADERSHIP BOARD MEMBER RESPONSIBILITIES:

Time Commitment: The NLB meets at Heinz Hall approximately six (6) times each year. Members are expected to attend NLB meetings and participate in at least one (1) project committee. NLB members are expected to attend and encourage friends/colleagues to attend NLB and PSO events. Each term is for one (1) year and members may serve a maximum of six (6) terms.

Financial Commitment: The annual membership fee currently is \$50 per person, and covers various overhead expenses related to the program, including receptions and presentations. Members are also required to hold a subscription to a Pittsburgh Symphony series of any type and make a contribution of any size to the Pittsburgh Symphony's Annual Fund campaign.
